

Professor Virginia Davis

Virginia Davis is Professor of Medieval History at Queen Mary University of London. She has written extensively for both academic and wider audiences on late medieval British history. Virginia served as Head of the Queen Mary School of History and from 2010-13 as Dean for Research in the Faculty of Humanities and Social Science. Issues of equality, particularly Gender Equality are of particular interest and she chaired QMUL's Gender Equality Committee for a number of years. She has significant experience of school governance as vice-chair of governors at Brookside School since 2013, and in the past as a parent governor at her own children's school in east London. She also served as a charity trustee for the Ragged School Museum in East London and as chair of one of the subject associations for university-level teaching, HistoryUK_HE.
